Parent Teacher Organization Meeting Minutes
February 14, 2017

Attendance:

Treasurer: Jenni Tamblingson volunteered to fill in as Treasurer but was unable to attend the meeting tonight. The group unanimously voted to approve her and Carrie will follow through with the bank to add her as a signor on account.

Mother / Son Event: Carrie went over the details of the event (see attached). The group approved that it was ok to hand out the less expensive soft plastic blue water bottles that we have leftover in our spiritwear gear to each son attending. Currently we have 14 kids signed up. If Janice is able to attend, she agreed to take some pictures during the event. It was suggested for the dodge ball games that maybe 10 might be a good number for dodge ball, too many, and the game takes too long to complete.

Movie Night: Michelle discussed the plans for an upcoming movie night. The group agreed that we should charge the usual \$5 per kid / \$10 maximum per family. Moana is the movie chosen. March 17 is the date selected.

Chess Club: Group voted to approve the Request for Funds of \$125 for the Chess Club to purchase a storage bin for their equipment. The request was from Sheila Jentsch. Carrie will forward the check to Sheila.

Playground Equipment for Middle School: Carrie notified the group that per our last meeting, the money that came in for Box Tops was forwarded to Dr. Jacobson and was designated to be used for Middle School playground equipment. Janice also notified Dr. Jacobson that there were additional balls available in the Health Room that were purchased with Campbell Soup labels and are to be used for both Elementary and Middle School.

Tax Form: Holly volunteered to take the tax form from Carrie and submit what was needed.

Budget: The group reviewed each line item of the proposed 2016-2017 budget and it was approved with a few changes. Carrie will incorporate the changes and distribute to the group.

Fun Fair: Lisa is not going to be able to do the Fun Fair this year, the time commitment is too big with all the activities, the Silent Auction (which requires online paperwork to apply for the donations), Kids Raffle, Games, Prize Station, Cake Walk, Food, Balloon Lady, etc. Lisa proposed some less time consuming fundraisers such as: Read-a-thon (there is a company called 99 Pledges that organizes these), or possibly an Art Gallery Night (this could be done through a company) and these activities would be less time consuming to plan and organize. Carrie is going to advertise that “we are in need of a Fun Fair Chairperson, in the event we don’t have someone step up then we will not be having a fun fair this year”.

Science Fair: We are unable to find someone who wants to lead the Science Fair. Carrie will contact Sandy Mountain and let her know we can help find volunteers or whatever else is needed but we will not be organizing a Science Fair.
