Our current account balance is approximately \$1,700 depending on box top deposits and if profits from spring pictures were deposited yet.

The group plans to meet every six weeks or so. Meetings will be led by the chair of the committee for the next event that is to take place.

A bake sale will be run in conjunction with the parent teacher conferences. Carrie Rydzewski will be sending an email request for parents to bring donated baked goods to the school, dropping them off on Thursday, November 20 or Monday, November 24. We will also be selling Spirit Wear. Holly Ternes is organizing the volunteers to work the sale.
